#### Comment year 2016

The year 2016 was the third year our Foundation really executed all of our intended activities, such as twin scholarship (three students from Indonesia and one student from the Netherlands), seminar for young potentential leaders, from several sectors of the society like business, academia, government, ngo's, ten from Indonesia and ten from the Netherlands.

Plus we organised this year two Frans Seda Lectures, one in Tilburg and one in Jakarta. The last one was combined with the Frans Seda award.

The donations in 2016 were more or less equal with the previous year.

The Board are finalizing a plan for donations in Indonesia, which will be executed in 2017.

As stated in the ANBI requirement the compensation for the boardmembers has been limited to a compensation of expenditures.

The board communicated usually by internet, phone and skype conference. In combination with the lecture we meet each other once in a year.

The rule is that the compensation of flightcosts is one flight economy in a year for the boardmembers.

The general expenses have increased because of necessary external support. The total of the general expenses are still reasonable in proportion with our activities (2016: appr. 10%).

The Seminar in The Hague expenditures were in 2016 quite higher than in 2015, because the costs of living in the Netherlands are higher than in Indonesia, where we had the Seminar in 2015.

Although the expenditures in 2016 were higher than our income, we still maintained a relative strong cash position.
